The program's distinctive approach favours networked, collaborative research that delivers practical solutions and outcomes for governments whilst offering a number of research activities, such as public lectures, conferences, and publications.

Along with ANZSOG's programs, the School holds a number of collaborative initiatives with its partners and key national and international networks that provide a platform for policy development, research, and analysis.
